TOURS EN LA ISLA

TOUR PARTE ALTA: Junco-Galapaguera seminatural-Puerto Chino-Progreso-El Ceibo.

Length of Visit: 4 hours.

Suggested Clothing: sneakers, pants, rain jacket, hat, water, sun block and insect repellent.

Upon leaving the hotel you will travel in car/bus to the highlands. The first stop is Progreso (20 mins in car), El Progreso is the site of the ruins of the sugar plantation and mansion of Manuel J. Cobos (for more information on this history, one can visit the Interpretation Center). From Progreso travel (20 mins) to the Tree House which has been built in the largest and oldest Ceiba tree on the island. At the Tree House visitors can climb ropes, swing on a rope swing, lounge in hammocks, or slide down a fire pole from the Tree house to the ground below. From the Tree House you will travel (30 mins) to El Junco, a large freshwater lake situated in the crater of a now dead volcano. At El Junco one can realize a walk around the perimeter of the lake, enjoy the views of the other side of the island of San Cristóbal, and watch the Frigate birds as they dive into the water to refresh and cleanse themselves. From El Junco you will travel (20 mins) to the Galapaguera Semi-Natural. At this site you can walk around the semi-natural habitat of the famous Giant Tortoise and look for them as they wander freely around the enclosure as if in their natural state, feeding on the Manzanillo tree (which for us is a poisonous fruit), or socializing in groups. After enjoying a day of marvelous sites and rich history you will return to the hotel where we invite you to enjoy a beautiful sunset from the second floor of the Miconia Cabañas Restaurant.

DAY TOUR

Length of stay: about 4 hours

Recommended attire: comfortable clothing, swimsuit and towel, sneakers or sport sandals to disembark at isla lobos, hat, sunblock, and camera (regular and/or underwater) bottle of water.

DESTINATION 1: LEON DORMIDO

To get to Leon Dormido (also known as kicker rock) you will travel by boat. During the trip be sure to enjoy views of the island coastline, keeping an eye out for nesting frigatebirds, schools of tuna or other pelagic fish, and, depending on the season, pods of dolphins.

Leon Dormido is a beautiful site for snorkeling or scuba diving. This rock, divided by a channel of water, is the result of a volcanic explosion which occurred millions of years ago along the ocean floor. Leon Dormido rises to heights of 148m and is the preferred resting and nesting site of many marine birds since disembarkation is prohibited and no other animals inhabit the area.

Beneath the surface you will have a chance to see the endemic galapagos shark (this is one of the best places to see these sharks, they are curious and may approach but are not aggressive), marine turtles, curious sea lions, eagle rays, and many tropical fish. On occasion there are also manta rays, hammerhead sharks, white tip reef sharks, and dolphins.

DESTINATION 2: ISLAS LOBOS

Isla Lobos is a wonderful site where several colonies of sea lions reside. Here you will begin by disembarking to realize a short (100-200m) walk along the length of the islet, your guide will explain the lifestyle of the sea lions and will also point out any nesting frigatebirds or blue footed boobies. This islet is also a great place to observe marine iguanas and lava lizards.

The water channel between Isla Lobos and the nearby shoreline of San Cristobal is extremely calm and crystal clear making it a great place to snorkel and look for sting rays, galápagos ringed puffer fish, sea stars and sea biscuits and of course to play with the extremely curious and friendly sea lion pups. Although the sea lions may come near you it is prohibited to touch or bother them.
